

## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN GODDARD COLLEGE AND SOUTHERN VERMONT COLLEGE


The purpose of this agreement is to effect the smooth transfer of graduates of Southern Vermont College's BA Writing Program to Goddard College's Masters of Fine Arts (MFA) in Writing Program.

1. Goddard College assures, on a space-available basis, the acceptance of Bachelor of Arts degree graduates from Southern Vermont College into Goddard College's MFA in Writing Program.
2. Goddard requires that incoming Southern Vermont College students have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and the recommendation of the Director of Southern Vermont College's Creative Writing Institute in order to bypass the admissions process and gain automatic acceptance into Goddard's MFA Writing program.
3. Transferring students are required to submit proposed study plans, tentative bibliographies and creative writing samples in order to effectively match them with Goddard faculty. These plans and samples should be submitted at least two months prior to the expected start date of the student's entry into the Goddard program.
4. Incoming Southern Vermont College students will be held to the same standards as any other incoming student. Students who lack skills in specific areas may expect to take an additional semester of graduate study in order to fulfill program requirements.
5. After a period of two years, Goddard College and Southern Vermont College will jointly assess the articulation agreement for the purposes of understanding and publishing the academic outcomes of this collaborative effort.
6. Goddard College and Southern Vermont College agree to publicize this agreement on their respective campuses.
7. Either College may cancel this agreement by giving the other a one-year notice.
