### **Tutoring Services**

Our Learning Cooperative provides peer and professional tutors to assist students with academic courses and study support for a variety of content areas including Anatomy and Physiology, Psychology, Accounting, and Statistics.

### **Courses and Supplemental Support**

Scheduled study sessions may accompany courses that have been identified as requiring extra support for student success.

### **Writing Support**

Writing tutors can help at any stage of the writing process from topic selection through the final draft.

### **Skill Building**

Individual sessions or workshops are available that focus on reading textbooks, note taking, study skills, time management, test-taking skills, or managing test-taking anxiety.

### **Learning Differences Support Program**

Reasonable accommodations are available to individuals with a documented disability including services for individuals with learning disabilities, physical disabilities, or ADHD.

### **Career Planning**

The Career Development Office offers free career interest assessment; career exploration through internships, part-time jobs, and volunteer experiences; job search assistance including resume writing, interview preparation, online job bank, and career/graduate school fairs.
