When making a determination of SLD, the ARC must consider all of the data and use the following to guide the eligibility decision: The RTI component of the evaluation must evidence underachievement (level) and insufficient growth (rate).

SLD identification is a team decision. In other words, assessment results alone can-not be used to determine eligibility. As as-sessment team members come to the process with different values about SLD determina-tion and service delivery, they shape the decision-making process in ways that may hinder accurate identification.
